

Autumn Term – Year 4

Welcome back...

Welcome back Year 4, we hope that you have all had a fantastic summer. We are very excited about this year, below are a few reminders for the coming term.

READING:

We teach reading as a whole class to develop the key skills of retrieval, prediction, questioning, clarifying, summarising and inference. Children will have the opportunity to read aloud within class during the week. Please encourage your child to read at home daily.

As a minimum, we ask that you sign your child's reading diary at least 3 times a week. Reading diaries will be checked on a **Monday** and diaries are expected to be in school **every day**. House points are awarded for reading at home.

Children will be assessed during their first week in Year 4 and reading books will be given out accordingly. When children have completed their book, they will be able to complete a comprehension quiz based on the book they have been reading in school and then their book will be changed.

We encourage children to read another text/book of their choice alongside their school reading book and always look forward to hearing about what they have been reading.

SPELLINGS:

We will talk to the children about their spellings, spellings will focus on the year 4 spelling patterns and spellings' from the national curriculum spelling list for years 3 and 4. Children will bring home spellings in a **yellow book** on a **Monday** which will need to be practised at home using **Look Say Cover Write Check**, in preparation for their **spelling test which will be on Friday**. Spellings will also be available on Seesaw.

Please sign the yellow book so that we know that you have seen your child's spellings, these will be checked when new spellings are given out on Mondays. **Spelling tests are completed in reading diaries on Fridays.**

HOMEWORK:

A homework task will be uploaded on to Seesaw each Wednesday and explained in class to the children. Homework tasks will be a range of maths and English activities, along with some topic work or projects. Homework will need to be completed by the following **Wednesday**. House points will be awarded for completed homework.

Times tables – children are expected to practice and learn their times tables and corresponding division facts at home to ensure they can recall these rapidly. We will post links and activities on Seesaw to assist children with learning their times tables.

A task will be uploaded on to Seesaw on 14/9/22 and we ask children to try to log on and send a response so that we know they are able to access the homework successfully. All login details will be given out next week. Formal homework will commence the following week.

PE:

During Autumn 1 PE will take place on Fridays, please make sure PE kits are in school in preparation for this. PE kits can be brought in on Mondays and kept in lockers then go home on Fridays after the PE session.

Please make sure that your child has suitable footwear for outdoor sessions. You may wish to provide a pair of dark coloured tracksuit trousers and a change of jumper as the weather starts to turn cooler. Please also make sure all kit is labelled clearly with your child's name. Children will be advised if this day is changed.

We will be swimming during this half term on Thursdays. **Swimming commences on Thursday 15th September.**
