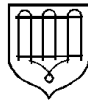

Perseverance

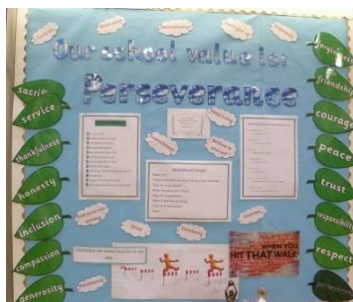
Let us run with perseverance the race that is before us.
