## School Lunches

**From 16<sup>th</sup> April school lunches will cost £2.30 a day - £11.50 a week.**

- Children **must** choose the meal of their choice – this can be done a day in advance, weekly or half termly.
- Meals must be chosen at least 24 hours in advance and paid for at the time of booking
- You **cannot** book and pay on the day
- Parents of Children with packed lunches will also have to log on and choose the 'packed lunch' option
- There will be a 'Deli Bar' available to KS2 (Year 3, 4, 5 & 6), this will be for a trial period and maybe opened up to the rest of the school at a later date.
- Log in details will remain the same

**All parents will need to book online including Universal Free School meals (Reception, Y1 & Y2) and Free School Meals Entitlements.**
