Headlice

A delicate subject, but we have been asked if we can send out a letter regarding head lice, there are signs that we may have a possible outbreak. Could we ask that parents check their child as soon as possible. If your child is infested you can get a treatment from the local chemist. There is no reason for your child to miss time from school. You will need to check other members of your family and you need to re-treat after a number of days as the eggs, which were not killed, will have hatched –that way it will prevent them re-occurring.
