Little Treasures' Nursery

I am writing to inform you that St Laurence's school, having received advice and guidance from the local authority, has taken a decision to change the status of the nursery provision we currently offer. As from 1st May the nursery will no longer be operated as a local authority maintained nursery but will become a governor led nursery.

The main reason for this decision is that changing the status of the nursery will make the provision more sustainable and allow us to confidently ensure its future. Over recent years we have had to rely on additional funding from the LA to continue to cover the costs of the nursery and we cannot guarantee the amount or availability of this additional funding on an on-going basis. The school remains fully committed to the delivery of high quality nursery provision and see this as being the basis on which the school is built. We have no plans to reduce the nursery hours and want to reassure parents and carers that the nursery will remain as an integral part of our school.

School Lunches

School lunches now cost £2.30 a day - £11.50 a week.

- Children **must** choose the meal of their choice – this can be done a day in advance, weekly or half termly.
- Meals must be chosen at least 24 hours in advance and paid for at the time of booking
- You **cannot** book and pay on the day
- **Parents of Children with packed lunches will also have to log on and choose the 'packed lunch' option**
- There will be a 'Deli Bar' available to KS2 (Year 3, 4, 5 & 6), this will be for a trial period and maybe opened up to the rest of the school at a later date.
- Log in details will remain the same

All parents need to book online including Universal Free School meals (Reception, Y1 & Y2) and Free School Meals Entitlements.

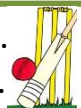
Now the weather is getting warmer the children no longer need their extra layers.
