

Reception –

READING

We will change your child's phonic books weekly after they are listened to. Last term we were sending out phonic books to support your child learning their sounds, over the next few weeks we will be sending out another book with letter formation sheets, this is to enhance their writing skills and a little bit everyday will help them massively. We will also be sending out our tricky words again, the children just have to learn these as they cannot be sounded out.

MYSTERY READER

We are always looking for Mystery Readers where you bring in a story of your choice and share it with the children. Thank you to those of you who managed this last term and if you would like to do it again the please let us know or if you are new to this, then I promise they are not scary, they just love to listen to someone else telling a story.
