To start with, I would just like to thank you all for your support last term. Because of your efforts, Year 6 transitioned back into school wonderfully. This term, we have lots of things to look forward to: we will begin preparations for our production; the house football tournament will be taking place and you will soon be getting letters outlining our plans for the end of term.

In English, we will be writing a biography about the famous diver Jacques Cousteau. We will also ensure that our knowledge of grammatical terminology is secure. If you would like to work on this at home, search “BBC KS2 Grammar”, where you will find information on all the terminology we use in class. In our Reading lessons, we will be engaging with a range of quality texts that link to our topics. As previously stated, it is essential that pupils continue to read for twenty minutes (or twenty pages) each day.

In Science, we will begin this term by looking at Charles Darwin and his theory of evolution and move on to studying animals including humans. In Geography, we will be studying South America. PE will continue to take place on Monday afternoons, with a focus on cricket.
