Reading Year 1 – Year 6

After trialling school books going home in select classes, the decision has been made to roll this out across the whole school. As of next week, your child will be bringing a school book home to read. This needs to be brought back to school each day. These books will only be touched by your child in school and when finished, we will quarantine the book in class before it goes back into general circulation.

This is a great opportunity to start hearing your child read more regularly again and we would encourage everyone to aim for at least twenty pages or twenty minutes of quality reading time each day – remembering that the conversations you have about a book are just as important as the reading itself.

We expect pupils of all ages and abilities to read aloud to a parent on a regular basis.



It has been brought to our attention by colleagues from partner agencies that a disturbing and controversial film called “Megan is missing” is currently being widely circulated on TikTok. The film is a fictional story about internet predators and child abduction and depicts scenes of extreme violence. A reminder that primary age children should not be accessing most social media platforms: if you have older children in your household who do, we would advise that you monitor your child's use of social media, and encourage them to talk to you about anything they see that is not appropriate.
