UNIFORM REMINDER

A sweatshirt in jade green, bearing the embroidered school badge. A plain polo shirt (underneath), either in Jade green or white.

Boys: Plain navy / black trousers or shorts.

Girls: Plain navy / black skirts. Skirts must be knee length. Navy / black pinafore. Plain navy / black trousers.
