



## Pupil Premium Support

The threshold for those families entitled to Pupil Premium support has changed recently, to take into account the impact of the pandemic and the rise in the Cost of Living. If you have any questions about whether you may be entitled to this or indeed what the benefits are please contact the office to speak to me.

### Evidence of income

To be eligible for free school meals, your families' annual household income must be no higher than the following:

£22,700 for families outside of London with one child

£26,300 for families outside of London with two or more children

## Music Lessons

Any children who are interested in learning a musical instrument in school can apply for support (if eligible or if they are in receipt of pupil premium) or for further information. There is a range of instruments that are available for children to learn: woodwind, brass strings (including Cello) and piano.
