Head lice

A delicate subject, but we have been asked if we can send out letters regarding head lice as some children are repeatedly being infested. Could we ask that all parents check their child as soon as possible. If your child is infested you can get a treatment from the local chemist. There is no reason for your child to miss time from school.

You will need to check other members of your family and you need to re-treat after a number of days as the eggs, which were not killed, will have hatched –that way it will prevent them re-occurring.

Head lice and nits are very common in young children and their families. They don't have anything to do with dirty hair and are Picked up by head-to-head contact. Please treat head lice as soon as you spot them. There's no need to keep your child off school if they have head lice
