UNIFORM REMINDER

A sweatshirt in jade green, bearing the embroidered school badge. A plain polo shirt (underneath), either in Jade green or white. Boys: Plain navy / black trousers or shorts. Girls: Plain navy / black skirts. Skirts must be knee length. Navy / black pinafore. Plain navy / black trousers. Summer wear: Polo shirt plus navy/black bottom half with an option of jade/white gingham checked dresses for girls. **Footwear**: Low heeled, black shoes or sensible black ankle boots. Trainers are not seen as healthy or sensible footwear to wear all day in school.

Jewellery: Jewellery <u>should not</u> be worn or brought into school. Watches can be worn but no responsibility for damage or loss can be accepted.

We also ask that nail varnish <u>is not</u> worn in school. The school cannot accept responsibility for injuries caused by the wearing of earrings. **Children with pierced ears who need to wear earrings should only**

Family Support

My name is Sarah Brown and I am the Family Support Worker here at St Laurence's Primary School. I have been working with children and families for over 10 years in Worcestershire and now in Shropshire.

I have been employed by the school to support our families with parenting and safeguarding.

- I will support, advise and inform families using my extensive experience and agency networking. I will try to help you with your child's education, health, parenting and wellbeing or support with agency referrals for specialist support with debts, worklessness, relationships or housing. Identifying things that you are worried about and things that are working well with your family. All families have strengths and these are identified when your family is struggling. I can try to provide a network of support using agencies and family/friends. Identifying when life is not going well and asking for some support is the first step to getting a better family life balance.
- Strengthening Families is the hub where referrals can be made to seek level 2 (low level), level 3 (targeted or multi-agency level need) or level 4 (Social Care Level.) These can be self-referrals or supported by the school.
