Reading

In Year 3, children are introduced to our KS2 reading scheme called Accelerated Reader. We will assess your child to find out what level they are reading at, and they will then be able to select a reading book from their personal range. When they have completed their book, they will do an online quiz to check their understanding of the text.

Please encourage your child to read to you at least **3 times a week**. This is very important, and your support is greatly appreciated. Children may write in their own diary, but we ask that you sign their book 3 times to confirm that they have read or discussed their book with you. **Reading diaries and books must be in school every day please.**
