
Class 3 Summer Term 2024

Welcome to the summer term. This term we have Mrs Nash and Mrs Pitt working within the class. Reading

In Year 3, children are introduced to our KS2 reading scheme called Accelerated Reader. We will assess your child to find out what level they are reading at, and they will then be able to select a reading book from their personal range. When they have completed their book, they will do an online quiz to check their understanding of the text.

Please read with your child at least **3 times a week**. This is very important, and your support is greatly appreciated. Children may write in their own diary, but we ask that you sign their book 3 times to confirm that they have read or discussed their book with you.

Reading diaries and books must be in school every day please.

PE/swimming

Year 3 children need to bring their kit in on a Monday as the day for PE may vary. This half term PE will be on a **Tuesday.** Girls also need a hair tie and need to remember to remove earrings before both PE and swimming sessions.

Swimming

After half term Year 3 will have swimming sessions on a **Monday** afternoon.

Spellings

This term we will continue to use the Pathways to Spell program. This has a spelling focus each week and children will receive different numbers of spellings, depending on the pattern.

The spelling test will take place on a **Friday** each week. New spellings will be given out on a **Monday** so please make sure that your child keeps their spelling book in their book bag.

Seesaw/ Homework

There will be a weekly homework task on Seesaw.
