

Autumn Term - Year 4

Welcome back Year 4, we hope that you have all had a fantastic summer. We are really looking forward to this year having heard such wonderful things from Miss Pick, below are a few reminders for the coming term:

READING:

We teach reading as a whole class to develop the key skills of retrieval, prediction, questioning, clarifying, summarising, and inference.

Children will have the opportunity to read aloud within class during the week. Please encourage your child to read at home daily.

As a minimum, we ask that you sign your child's reading diary at least three times a week. Reading diaries will be checked on a **Monday** and diaries are expected to be in school **every day**. House points are awarded for reading at home.

Children will be assessed during their first week in Year 4 and reading books will be given out accordingly. When children have completed their book, they will be able to complete a comprehension quiz based on the book they have been reading in school and then their book will be changed.

We encourage children to read another text/book of their choice alongside their school reading book.

SPELLINGS:

During the first half term we will revisit key words to check that the children have remembered these spellings. Spellings will focus on the Year 4 spelling patterns and spellings from the national curriculum spelling list for Years 3 and 4. There will be daily activities working towards achieving the Year 4 spelling goals.

Children will bring home spellings on a **Monday** which will need to be practised at home in preparation for their **spelling test which will be on Friday**. Spelling tests are completed in reading diaries on Fridays.

New spellings are given out on Monday's and the weekly spelling test will be on Friday's.

HOMEWORK

A homework task will be uploaded on to Seesaw or sent home on paper and explained in class to the children. Homework tasks will be a range of maths and English activities, along with topic work or projects. Homework will need to be completed ready for the following Monday. House points will be awarded for completed homework.

Times tables - children are expected to practice and learn their times tables and corresponding division facts at home to ensure they can recall these rapidly. We will post links and activities on Seesaw to assist children with learning their times tables.

Homework is given out every Monday and collected in the following Monday.

A task will be uploaded on to Seesaw on Monday 7th September '26 and we ask children to try to log on and send a response so that we know they are able to access the homework successfully. All login details have been given out, if your child has not received one or you experience problems, please let us know as soon as possible.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

During Autumn 1, Swimming will be taking place every Thursday and Outdoor PE every Monday afternoon. Please make sure PE kits are in school in preparation for this. PE kits can be brought in on Mondays and kept in their lockers then go home on Fridays. Please make sure that your child has suitable footwear for outdoor sessions. You may wish to provide a pair of dark coloured tracksuit trousers and a change of jumper as the weather starts to turn cooler. Please also make sure all kit is labelled clearly with your child's name. You will be notified if these days are changed for any reason.

PE (Outdoor) - Monday Afternoon Swimming - Thursday Afternoon
